**PROPERLY INFLATE TIRES**  
When tires aren't inflated properly it's like driving with the parking brake on and this can waste a mile or two per gallon. By maintaining the correct air pressure, you can realize a 10 percent improvement in fuel economy. Check your owner's manual for the proper air pressure for your vehicle's tires.

**FUEL SAVING TIPS:**
