### RE: Chile Earthquake Relief Efforts

We are a group of dedicated professionals and government officials working to send emergency relief assistance to remote areas of Chile devastated by the earthquake (and resulting tsunami) on February 27, 2010. Our goal is to provide long term relief to the affected rural areas whose energy and drinking water supplies were destroyed.

We are working with Nelson Stevens, owner of Wireless Energy in the city of Puerto Montt, whose company has been critical in bringing renewable energy to Chile's rural communities since 1996. In response to the catastrophic situation, Wireless Energy has mobilized teams to build solar energy trailers that would provide energy and communication lines in addition to clean water to remote areas that were highly impacted by the recent earthquake. In order to support these efforts, we are asking for donations to aid these areas because they so greatly need our help. Below are items that are needed at this time:

- Photovoltaic (PV) Solar Panels 12 V DC or 24 V DC and 50 to 150 Watts in size
- Power Inverters
- Street lights
- Wind Energy
- Portable water treatment units (or water purifiers)
- Water desalination units
